12. Confirming/adjusting the level of the membership fees

The general assembly approved the following changes suggested by the board:

- allowing institutions with membership status to send 2 representatives to the NOFOD conference for a reduced fee
- increasing the institutional membership fees for Norway, Iceland and Sweden: to 1000NOK, 8000ISK and 1050SEK (according to Euro exchange rate)
- increasing the student membership fees for Norway and Sweden: to 250NOK and 250SEK (according to Euro exchange rate)
- increasing the individual membership fees for Norway and Sweden: to 450NOK and 450SEK (according to Euro exchange rate)
- allowing retired members to pay the reduced membership fee

The question of whether *The Nordic Journal of Dance* should be in paper as well as on line, was postponed to the next general assembly.

13. Report from the Nordic Journal of Dance

Hilde Rustad gave a presentation of and a short report on *The Nordic Journal of Dance* – a collaboration between NOFOD and SANS. A future special issue of the journal will work as an edited and peer reviewed form of proceeding for the present conference. Guidelines for authors will be announced on the website (see appendix).

There were no reports from the special interest groups, but some of them are meeting during the conference.

15. The next conference

Irene reported that she and Halldis are planning to have the next conference in Oslo in 2024.
